We love our fellow CAHIP-OC chapter's willingness to partner with us to make sure we are covered for our meetings, especially this year when we have 12 meetings to attend and fewer IE chapter members attending. Pat & Ryan, could you please review the meeting schedule and let me know which meetings you would like & able to attend so I can update the schedule? I have 2 meetings that I'm still working on getting set up, and really, to be honest, may end up being Zoom meetings the following week, but I will make sure to update the schedule as changes occur prior to Wednesday.

- Business casual or business professionals are expected for these meetings.

Legislative Priorities

- This year, we will focus on five specific bills, which we will discuss in length on Tuesday, 5/14.
 - AB 2200 ("Guaranteed Health Care for All")
 - AB 2028 ("Medical Loss Ratios" for CA dental plans) This may be dropped as the bill did not pass this year because the author canceled the hearing on this bill.
 - SB 230 ("Income Tax: Health Savings Accounts")
 - SB 1236 ("Medicare Supplement Coverage: Open Enrollment Periods")
 - SB 1180 ("Health Care Coverage: Emergency Medical Services")
